पाणी बिलाची थकबाकी असलेल्या १७८० नळ जोडण्या खंडित

ठाणे : ठाणे महापालिकेची पाणी बिल थकबाकी वसुलीकरता पाणी पुरवठा विभागाने मोठ्या प्रमाणात कारवाई सुरु केली आहे. या मोहिमेत संपूर्ण महापालिका क्षेत्रात आतापर्यंत १७८० नळ जोडण्या खंडित केल्या असून १५२ मोटर पंप जप्त केले आहेत.

तसेच, एकूण ५० पंप रुम सील करण्यात आले असून थकबाकी वसुलीसाठी ३३५४ थकबाकीदार ग्राहकांना नोटीसा पाठवण्यात आल्या आहेत. या पाणी बिल वसुली अभियानात आतापर्यंत सुमारे ५९.४३ कोटी रुपयांची वसुली करण्यात आली आहे.

महापालिकेची पाणी बिल रक्कम सुमारे २२४ कोटी रुपयांच्या घरात आहेत. त्यापैकी, ७६ कोटी रुपये ही थकबाकी असून चालू वर्षाची बिल रक्कम ही १४८ कोटी रुपये आहे. पाणी बिलाची थकबाकी न भरल्यास नळ जोडणी खंडित करून पाणी पुरवठा बंद करण्याची कारवाई सुरु करण्यात



आली आहे. महापालिका आयुक्त सौरभ राव यांनी याबाबत स्पष्ट निर्देश दिले आहेत. तसेच, आयुक्तस्तरावर या वसुलीबाबत सातत्याने आढावाही घेतला जात आहे.

अतिरिक्त आयुक्त संदीप माळवी यांनी बिलाच्या साप्ताहिक वसुलीचे लक्ष्य

निर्धारित करून पाणी बिल वसुली अभियान सुरु करण्यास सांगितले आहे. त्यानुसार, पाणी बिलाच्या थकबाकीसह वसुलीसाठी महापालिकेच्या सर्व प्रभागात नळ जोडणी खंडित करणे, मोटर पंप जप्त करणे, मीटर रुम सील करण्यात येत आहेत. तसेच, पाणी बिलाचा भरणा न करता, खंडित नळ जोडणी परस्पर पुन्हा कार्यान्वित करून घेतल्यास गुन्हे दाखल करण्याचे निर्देश देण्यात आले आहेत.

प्रभाग समितीतील पाणी पुरवठा विभागाच्या अभियंत्यांच्या नेतृत्वात पाणी बिल वसुलीची मोहीम राबवण्यात येत असून कारवाईत हलगर्जी करू नये, असे त्यांना निर्देश देण्यात आले आहे. नागरिकांनी पाणी बिल वेळेत भरावे, तसेच थकबाकीदारांनी बिल भरून पालिकेस सहकार्य करावे. अन्यथा नळ जोडणी खंडित करण्यात येईल, असे उपनगर अभियंता (पाणी पुरवठा) विनोद पवार यांनी स्पष्ट केले आहे.

भिवंडीतून सहा बांगलादेशी महिलांना अटक ठाणे गुन्हे अन्वेषण शाखेची कारवाई

शाखेने अटक केली. त्यांच्याविरोधात पारंप्र अर्धिनियम, परकीय नागरिकांचा कायदा कलमांतर्गत भिवंडी शहर पोलीस ठाण्यात गुन्हा दाखल करण्यात आला आहे. भिवंडीमध्ये बेकायदेशीरपणे बांगलादेशी महिला वास्तव्यास असल्याची माहिती ठाणे गुन्हे अन्वेषण शाखेच्या अनैतिक मानवी वाहतुक प्रतिबंधक कक्षाला मिळाली होती. या माहितीच्या आधारे, पोलीसांच्या पथकाने हनुमान टेकडी परिसरातून सहा बांगलादेशी महिलांना ताब्यात घेतले. त्यांच्याकडे चौकशी केली असता, त्यांच्याकडे पारंप्र आढळून आले नाही. या सर्व महिलांनी त्या बेकायदेशीरपणे भारतात आल्याचे कबूल केले. येथील भाड्याच्या घरामध्ये त्या वास्तव्य करत होत्या. या महिलांविरोधात पोलीसांनी भिवंडी शहर पोलीस ठाण्यात गुन्हा दाखल केला आहे. त्यांच्याविरोधात पारंप्र अर्धिनियम १९२० चे कलम ३,४, परकीय नागरिकांचा कायदा १९४६ चे कलम १३, १४-अ (ब) अंतर्गत गुन्हा दाखल करण्यात आला आहे.

The Kamlesh Nagarkoti story: Battling injuries, long rehab, fresh start with CSK



NEW DELHI: Kamlesh Nagarkoti's career has been riddled with injuries, keeping the right-arm pacer off the cricket field more than on it. A promising talent from India's victorious 2018 Under-19 World Cup squad, Nagarkoti became an IPL sensation that same year when the Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) bought him for a whopping Rs 3.2 crore after a fierce bidding war.

Nothing went as he would have liked from there on as the seamer, known for consistently clocking 140 plus kmph, was forced to miss the entire season due to a foot injury before the tournament began. The KKR think-tank retained him in 2019 but he remained off-field for another season due to a back injury. When he finally made his IPL debut in 2020, the promising quick played 10 games and managed just 5 wickets. Released by KKR ahead of the IPL 2022 Mega Auction, Nagarkoti was picked up by the Delhi Capitals for Rs 1.1 crore but featured in only one match before a back injury ended his season.

At the recent IPL 2025 mega auction, interest naturally wasn't high for Nagarkoti and Chennai Super Kings (CSK) got his services for a bid of Rs 30 lakh. For a player who has been battling a lot of injury issues for last six years, it was the end of a very long wait. "I have been waiting for this for a long time. I am grateful that I have got an opportunity once again. I am back again where I always wanted to be. I am eager to join CSK, and that's because of Mahendra Singh Dhoni sir.

'Can A 13-Year-Old Hit Such A Long Six?': Former Pakistan Pacer Questions Vaibhav Suryavanshi's Age

New Delhi - Recently becoming the youngest player to be picked at an IPL auction, Vaibhav Suryavanshi recently represented an India U19 team at the Asia Cup 2024 in UAE where his team finished as the runners-up. Suryavanshi was picked by Rajasthan Royals at the mega auction for Rs 1.1 crore in Jeddah.

At the U19 Asia Cup, after a quiet start, Suryavanshi showed his wares with back-to-back blis-

tering half-centuries that propelled India into the final. Against UAE, he the 13-year-old opener belted an unbeaten 76 off 46 with three fours and six sixes. And then in the semifinal against Sri Lanka, he led India's successful chase of 174 with a 36-ball 67 during which he struck six fours and five sixes.

Former Pakistan fast bowler Junaid Khan is in disbelief at the long sixes that Suryavanshi blasted against Sri Lanka in Shar-



jah insinuating if 13 is his real age.

"Can a 13-year-old kid really hit such a long six?????" Junaid wrote on Instagram while sharing a

clip of a six Suryavanshi off Sri Lankan pacer Dulnith Sigera as the ball landed deep into the stands.

Recently, Suryavanshi's father Sanjeev brushed aside the age controversy and said his son can undergo bone test if needed.

lia aged 13 years and 187 days which made him the youngest ever to do so in youth cricket. Sanjeev told News18 that growing up, they faced financial challenges. "We faced many difficulties, which also included a financial crisis. When Vaibhav was five years old, I used to make him practice cricket at our doorstep. At the age of 7, Vaibhav was enrolled in Samastipur Sports Academy.

'I wonder if Andy Murray can contribute to Novak Djokovic's game': Rublev questions Serbian's coaching decision

New Delhi - Aiming to bounce back to form in 2025, Novak Djokovic appointed Andy Murray as his coach in November this year. Murray, who announced his retirement earlier this year, will be on court with Djokovic from the 2025 Australian Open.

The decision was bombshell news for tennis fans, experts and players. World No. 8 Andrey Rublev also joined the bandwagon and he revealed that he was left confused by the announcement as he didn't see how it could benefit Djokovic. But



Rublev also felt that their friendship could be beneficial to Djokovic during the season.

"Novak is one of the most accomplished players in history. In that way, I wonder if Andy can contribute to his game and add new elements. On the other hand, they are good friends, which be-

fits their collaboration. We must remember that positive energy sometimes gives much more at this level than anything else. Novak knows tennis better than everyone, and he can feel fresh and motivated with Andy in his box. It will be interesting to see Andy's reactions when Novak gets too emotional and throws bad words at his team," said Rublev.

Djokovic and Murray met 36 times, with the Serbian ace leading 25-11 overall and 11-8 in finals. Ten of their face-offs have been in majors, with Djokovic leading 8-2. They are also one of the two male pairs to have contested the finals of each of the four majors (Djokovic-Nadal is the other). Meanwhile, the Serbian leads 20-8 on hard courts and 5-1 on clay. Murray won their two matches played on grass. The duo are almost of the same age, with Murray being a week older. They went to training camp together and as juniors, Murray won the first fixture they played against each other.

'Bumrah may get more wickets but Shami India's best bowler, Siraj nowhere near him: West Indies legend Andy Roberts

New Delhi - Legendary West Indies cricketer Andy Roberts heaped praise on Mohammed Shami, calling him "India's best bowler." Roberts, a daunting member of the famous West Indies pace quartet - Michael Holding, Joel Garner, and Colin Croft being the others - that terrorised batters across the globe in the 1970s and 80s, said Jasprit Bumrah might get more wickets but Shami is the complete package who has more control and can seam and swing the ball

both ways. "Shami has been India's best bowler for a while. He may not get the amount of wickets Jasprit Bumrah gets, but he's the full package and is more consistent than the rest. Shami swings the ball, Shami seams the ball and Shami's control is as good as Bumrah's," Roberts told Mid-day.

Roberts, who picked up 202 wickets in 47 Tests at an average of 25.61, said Mohammed Siraj, India's second-best seamer af-



ter Bumrah in Australia, is nowhere near Shami's class. Shami should play. Mohammed Siraj is now-

here near Shami," Roberts added.

When will Shami go to Australia?

Roberts' comments come at a time when Shami's availability for the remainder of the Border-Ga-

vaskar Trophy is still in doubt. The veteran of 64 Tests has not played for India since the ODI World Cup in November last year. His last Test match was also against Australia in the WTC final in June last year.

After recovering from a long injury layoff, Shami has looked in fine form for Bengal in the solitary Ranji trophy match and T20s that he has played. After playing a major role in taking Bengal to the knockouts, picking up 8 wickets in

seven matches at a 7.67 economy, Shami played a match-winning hand with both bat and ball against Chandigarh to take them to the quarterfinals. Shami scored an invaluable 17-ball-32 and bowled 13 dot balls in his four overs.

Despite Shami giving a good account of himself in the Syed Mushtaq Ali matches, the NCA is yet to give him a green signal for the Australia Tests. After India lost the second Test in Adelaide, captain Rohit Sharma said "doors are

always open for Shami" but has developed a new swelling on his knee that the medical team is monitoring. The five-match Border-Gavaskar Trophy currently stands 1-1. The third Test at the Gabba in Brisbane is slated to begin on Saturday. It is safe to say that there is no chance of Shami being available for that match, but the possibility of seeing him in action for the Boxing Day Test in Melbourne cannot be ruled out.
