व्यवस्थापकीय संचालक जयश्री भोज आणि संबंधित विभागांचे वरिष्ठ अधिकारी उपस्थित होते. मार्च २०२४ मध्ये सुरु करण्यात आलेल्या 'इंडिया एआय मिशन' अंतर्गत देशभरात 'एआय' क्षमता वाढवण्यासाठी १० हजार ३७२ कोटी रुपयांचा निधी मंजूर करण्यात आला आहे. यात इंडिया एआय डेटासेट्स प्लॅटफॉर्म, ऑफलाईन डेव्हलपमेंट प्रकल्प, ग्राफिक प्रोसेसिंग युनिट्स, इंडिया एआय इनोवेशन सेंटर, फ्युचर स्किल्स प्रोग्राम आणि एआय महापालिकेच्या आयुक्त तथा प्रशासक मनिषा खत्री यांनी काढले असून त्याची समावेश आहे.

नाशिक (सचिन कदम) - विकसन अर्थात बांधकाम परवानगीचे प्रस्ताव नव्या वर्षात केवळ ऑनलाईन पद्धतीने स्वीकारले जाणार आहेत. तांत्रिक अडचणीचे कारण देऊन ही प्रकरणे विकासकांच्या मागाणीनुसार मनपा आयुक्तांच्या मान्यतेने ऑफलाईन स्वीकारण्यास मान्यता दिली गेली होती. नव्या नियंत्रणामुळे त्यावर फुली मारण्यात आली आहे.या संदर्भात आदेश महापालिकेच्या आयुक्त तथा प्रशासक मनिषा खत्री यांनी काढले असून त्याची

परंतु, बीपीएमएस प्रणालीद्वारे विकसन प्रस्ताव सादर करताना काही प्रस्ताव फक्त ऑनलाईन पद्धतीने सादर करावेत, असे आयुक्त येत होत्या. अशावेळी ती खत्री यांनी सूचित केले आहे. प्रकरणे आयुक्तांच्या मान्यतेने मनपा आयुक्तपदाचा कार्यभार ऑफलाईन पद्धतीने सादर स्वीकारताना मनिषा खत्री करण्यास परवानगी दिली जात यांनी शासकीय प्रणालीचा होती. नव्या सूचनेने ही पद्धत वापर करण्याचे स्पष्ट केले आता बंद करण्यात आली. होते. ऑनलाईन बांधकाम शासनाच्या बीपीएमएस कार्यप्रणाली विकसन तून विकसन प्रस्ताव मंजुरीची कार्यवाही होणे अपेक्षित आहे. त्यामुळे एक जानेवारी २०२५ पासून नगरनियोजन विभागाकडून दिल्या जाणाऱ्या सर्व प्रकारच्या बसणार आहे.

## Shubman Gill IN, Rohit Sharma Dropped! Speculations Rife As India's Practice Session Hints At Historic Snub



New Delhi - India captain Rohit Sharma could be dropped from the playing XI for the fifth Test against Australia at the Sydney Cricket Ground.

The speculations were fueled after coach Gautam Gambhir refused to confirm Rohit Sharma's place in the XI. When asked why Rohit was absent from the pre-match conference and if he'd feature in the XI, Gambhir said a coach's presence should be good enough, adding that a call on the XI would be taken after looking at the pitch and conditions.

Rohit Sharma mustered only 31 runs in three Tests in the Border-Gavaskar Trophy which sparked outrage against the skipper as the calls for axe grew louder. While the coach stayed mum on the captain's potential snub from the XI, India's practice session did drop a few hints. Rohit Sharma wasn't practicing slip catching, with Virat Kohli, KL Rahul, and Nitish Reddy taking charge. Another massive hint about Rohit's potential axe was his absence from the net session. While the likes of Yashasvi Jaiswal, Virat Kohli, KL Rahul, and Ravindra Jadeja batted, Rohit

did not come for the session at the time of writing. Shubman Gill, Dhruv Jurel, and Rishabh Pant also came out with their pads on. If Rohit Sharma is dropped, Shubman Gill is most likely to replace him in the XI. Gill was dropped from the fourth Test after poor returns in the first three Tests. If Rohit misses out on a berth at the SCG, Jasprit Bumrah will lead the side in the final Test. Bumrah led the team in Rohit Sharma's absence in Perth as India scripted history after picking an emphatic 295-run win. India are 2-1 behind in the series and must ensure a win at SCG to retain the Border-Gavaskar Trophy. A win in Sydney will also keep India's WTC final hopes alive.

## Emma Raducanu pulls out of Australian Open warmup with back niggle

New Delhi - Grand Slam champion Emma Raducanu has withdrawn from the Auckland Open due to a back injury, dealing a blow to her preparations for the Australian Open. The 22-year-old British tennis player was scheduled to face Robin Montgomery of the United States in the first round of the ASB Classic on Tuesday. However, Raducanu has decided to travel to Melbourne to continue her preparations for the Australian Open, which begins on January 12. Raducanu, a Grand Slam champion and sixth seed at the Auckland warm-up event, expressed her disappointment in a statement: "I've tried my

best to be ready. I love Auckland and the fans here, but unfortunately, I've picked up a back niggle and won't be ready in time." Since her remarkable US Open victory in 2021, Raducanu has faced persistent injury setbacks. This year, she skipped five tournaments in the WTA's Asia swing after spraining ligaments in her foot. Additionally, she spent much of the previous season recovering from ankle and wrist surgeries. The 22-year-old managed to play only three matches after the Seoul injury in September, all of which she won while representing Great Britain at the Billie Jean King Cup Finals. Despite this success, she heads into the Australian Open without any recent match practice.

## Big blow to India, star player ruled out of 5th Test against Australia in Sydney, head coach Gautam Gambhir confirms

New Delhi - In a big setback to Team India, their star pacer Akash Deep has been ruled out of the fifth and last Test against Australia at the Sydney Cricket Ground (SCG). India's head coach Gautam Gambhir confirmed the news during pre-match press conference.

Notably, Akash Deep picked five wickets in two matches that he played in the ongoing Test series against Australia.

The 28-year-old right-arm pacer has been experiencing a niggle, which could be attributed to the heavy workload he has undertaken in the series. He bowled a total of 87.5 overs across two Test matches.

We are going to have a look at the wicket and announce the playing XI tomorrow," Gambhir added. Australia have announced their playing XI for the fifth Test against India with big changes. Australia have dropped Mitchell Marsh and replaced him with Beau Webster, who will be making his debut in Sydney. Meanwhile, Mitchell Starc has been declared

fit to feature in the final showdown in Sydney. Sam Konstas, Usman Khawaja, Marnus Labuschagne, Steve Smith, Travis Head, Beau Webster, Alex Carey (wk), Pat Cummins (captain), Mitch Starc, Nathan Lyon, Scott Boland.

India haven't enjoyed best of the outing in the series so far. After starting the tour on a high with resounding 195-run win over Australia in series opener in Perth, India lost two matches followed by a draw. It will be a must-win contest for India in Sydney if they want to boost their slim WTC final chances.

## India's WTC Final Odds Spike After Pat Cummins' Massive Decision For Sri Lanka Tour

New Delhi - The defeat to Australia in the Boxing Day Test at the MCG dented India's hopes of reaching the WTC final. South Africa's win over Pakistan sealed a spot for the Proteas in the WTC final, leaving India and Australia on a knife edge for the second berth. India for most of the WTC cycle looked certain to play the final, but the 3-0 whitewash against New Zealand at home followed by defeats in Adelaide and Sydney pegged them back. The Rohit Sharma-led side

needs a win in Sydney to keep the hopes alive. A win alone, however, won't be enough for team India as they would need Sri Lanka to beat Australia 2-0 in the upcoming series. Australia are a brute force and beating them won't be easy for the Lankans, however, they received a major boost after Pat Cummins confirmed his decision to skip the Sri Lanka tour. The Australia captain revealed that the death of his mother last year changed his priorities in life as he learned that family always comes first. "In some ways it really makes you focus in on what I think is important," he told the Daily Telegraph at the launch of the Pink Test. "It's family, it's enjoyment, it's trying to find joy in life and I

think that's been a slight shift in the way I've approached playing and touring and it's just given me that real decluttering mindset," he added. "When you go out you just want to play well and of course there's going to be pressure, but you don't want to forget that what mum and dad used to say to us every time we went and played as kids, was to go and enjoy it. Try your best, but make sure you enjoy it. I try and remind myself of that every time I go on a tour or play," Cummins said.
